## Requirements & Conditions for Filming at The Historic Dockyard Chatham

These may vary per enquiry, depending on your particular brief and once full details of the project have been received.

Key requirements/conditions

Before filming can proceed we will need to have received the following:

- 1. Signed Contract
- 2. Signed CHDT Rules & Guidelines
- 3. Proof of Public Liability Insurance to a value of £10,000,000, valid for the entire time you shall be working onsite
- 4. A Risk Assessment and Method Statement, completed and signed
- 5. A Covid-19 Risk Assessment, showing how your production will work to ensure a Covid-safe environment.
- 6. Payment in full
- 7. A full schedule, outlining all activities, timings, stunts, special effects, etc.
- 8. Full details of any equipment and vehicles you shall be bringing onsite, and of any power requirements. PAT certificates must be shown for all electrical items when requested.
- 9. Registration details for any vehicles coming onsite.

You are also required to visit the Chatham Historic Dockyard Trust site in advance of and filming/photography, and to meet with our Filming team.
