

Requirements & Conditions for Filming at The Historic Dockyard Chatham

These may vary per enquiry, depending on your particular brief and once full details of the project have been received.

Key requirements/conditions

Before filming can proceed we will need to have received the following:

1. Signed Contract
2. Signed CHDT Rules & Guidelines
3. Proof of Public Liability Insurance to a value of £10,000,000, valid for the entire time you shall be working onsite
4. A Risk Assessment and Method Statement, completed and signed
5. A Covid-19 Risk Assessment, showing how your production will work to ensure a Covid-safe environment.
6. Payment in full
7. A full schedule, outlining all activities, timings, stunts, special effects, etc.
8. Full details of any equipment and vehicles you shall be bringing onsite, and of any power requirements. PAT certificates must be shown for all electrical items when requested.
9. Registration details for any vehicles coming onsite.

You are also required to visit the Chatham Historic Dockyard Trust site in advance of and filming/photography, and to meet with our Filming team.
