CHARITY

WE ARE AN AWARD WINNING CHARITY WITH A TRACK RECORD OF SUCCESSFULLY UNLOCKING HERITAGE FOR PUBLIC BENEFIT.

The Chatham Historic Dockyard Trust (the Trust) is a charitable organisation entrusted with the stewardship of The Historic Dockyard Chatham - an 80 acre maritime site that once was part of the former Royal Dockyard Chatham. It has been associated with many of the most significant events, figures and technological advances that have shaped our history - from the Spanish Armada to Charles Dickens and submarine construction. The Trust cares for over

70,000 objects related to the Dockyard's past and carries out specific research into the Dockyard's rich and varied history. Three historic warships and over 100 listed buildings form part of a dedicated preservation strategy. From projects focused on the lives of Dockyard workers, to the tragedies suffered in battle and conflict, to revealing untold histories of Women in the Dockyard and Black Lives in Kent, we continue to build the picture of the role and impact of the Dockyard over four hundred years.
